School Card Scheme

Income Limits for the School Card Scheme have increased by \$20,596 this year for 1 dependent child. The criteria for the scheme is below. If you think that you may be eligible or would like more information regarding this please contact Tracey or Chris in the school office, we can help with filling in the forms and any questions you may have.

The School Card Scheme, including the process for verifying declared income is administered by the Department for Education and Child Development (DECD). School Card assistance is available for dependent students from 4 years of age receiving full-time schooling at a government school.

Eligibility for School Card assistance is dependent upon the combined family gross income for the 2016-2017 financial year being within the following School Card income limits
