### HEALTHY EATING POLICY

The [Eat Well SA Healthy Eating Guidelines for SA School and Preschools \(Healthy Eating Guidelines\)](#) promote a whole school approach to learning, health and wellbeing for students in relation to food and nutrition. These guidelines reflect and support a number of Commonwealth and state policies and were issued to all schools in 2004, providing a framework for planning strategies to ensure children and students learn about, experience and practise healthy eating. They reflect an understanding that effective learning about healthy eating must be supported in all aspects of the learning environment and for this reason, the guidelines apply to all learning programs and school settings such as the canteen and OSHC.

At Clovelly Park PS, this means:  
'Food and nutrition' is taught in all classrooms as part of the Health and PE curriculum  
Food and beverages are not given as rewards or treats to students  
Some RED category choices (food and drinks which are highly processed, energy dense and nutrient poor) may be provided on a maximum of two occasions a term in certain situations, such as whole of school or class celebrations
