Dear Families,
Thankyou for your support and warm welcome in my first term at Clovelly. I have really enjoyed getting to know the students and staff and have appreciated the time that many of you have taken to meet with me formally, or chat at "the gate" at the end of the day.

As many of you are aware, the car park is closely monitored at the end of the day to reduce the potential safety risks as we are continually concerned about safety when children and adults cross through the car park to leave the site at the end of the day. As a result, we have been working with an artist to create an art work that serves two purposes. The first is to welcome families and visitors into our site and the second is to create a barrier where the current red line is so that pedestrians cannot easily step into the car park area. We look forward to improved car park safety as a result.

As we are at the end of term, it is a great opportunity to remind families about the importance of students regular attendance at school.

Whilst we realise that students are absent from school for a variety of reasons, it is important to consider the impact of regular absences and lateness. As part of our Written School Report at the end of Term 2 and 4, we report the number of days late and absent. The number of days missed sometimes comes as a surprise to families.

Whilst an occasional day home due to illness is to be expected, regular absence and lateness can have a significant impact on your child's academic and social learning . If you want your child to *Be the best learner they can be*, they need to be at school!

As indicated in previous newsletters, we will report on the previous weeks attendance rate and the year to date percentage. As you can see, our average attendance rate for this term is 93% which is 2% under our target. We need your support to improve our percentages and reach our target every week.

As you are aware, we recently introduced the Skoolbag app to assist us to communicate with you. In the future, you will be able to inform us of your child's absence using the app. We will let you know when this is available to you. Whilst we are waiting for this feature to be available, we remind you that you can inform us of absence via a phone call or email to the front office or via the communication processes directly with the class teacher.
