Dear Families,

I am writing to inform you that Clovelly Park Primary School will be **closed** from **2pm on Thursday 12 September** due to a vote for industrial action by members of the Australian Education Union at this site.

The Education Director has approved the closure on the grounds that insufficient staff will be on duty to enable me as Principal to ensure that adequate standards of student safety and welfare can be provided.

Normal education programs will resume on Friday 13 September 2019. Please be advised that the OSHC will be available to cover the period of the industrial action. Families who wish to use this service must book a place by contacting the OSHC on 0418585142 by Tuesday 10th September 3pm to ensure appropriate staffing ratios are maintained. Families who have not booked a place at the OSHC by this time will not be able to access the service.
