On Thursday, 10 September, our school acknowledged R U OK? Day. Students and staff were encouraged to wear yellow, show off their dance moves in the gym and participate in activities to explore the importance of friendship.

We're happy to report, the day was a success. The yard looked like a sea of yellow and children laughed and grooved in the gym during break times; the gym looked like a yellow wave!

The social work students worked with each class to deliver activities. Some examples of the activities included: drawing a picture of being a good friend (R/Y1), recording how someone would look if they were OK or not OK (Y2/Y3), discussions about how to check in with each other (Y4-Y7). All students learned the four steps to asking, 'R U OK?': Ask, Listen, Encourage action and Check-in.

School Photo Day has been scheduled for Thursday 22nd October. **All students must be in school uniform.** Please ensure your child has suitable clothes that meet the Dress Code.

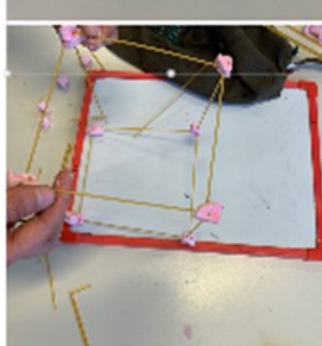
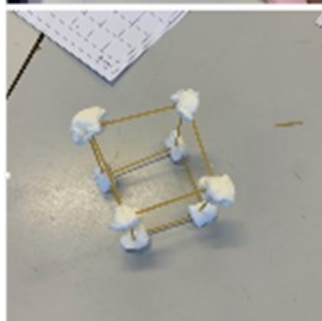
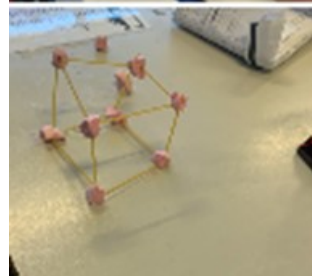
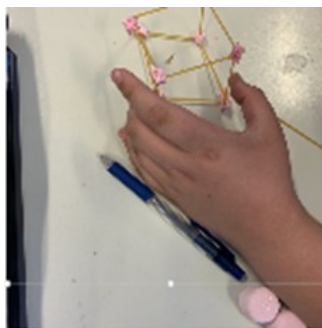
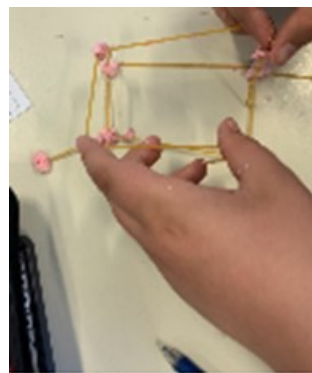
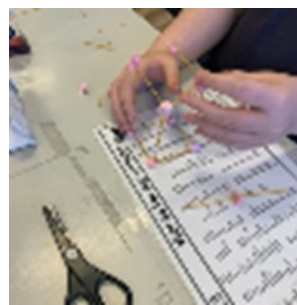
If your child has lost their uniform, please remember to check 'lost property' in the front office.

This is the only safe place to cross the road and is where drivers expect the children to cross the road.

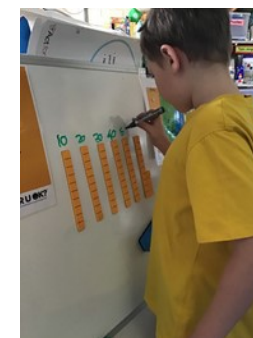
