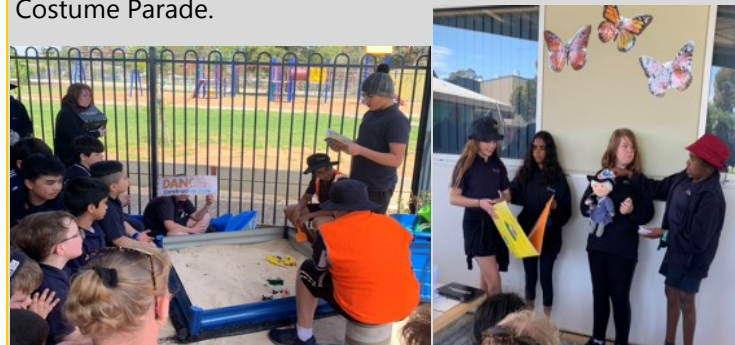

OSHC is pleased to inform you that we will be going to online enrolment and bookings using the "Fully Booked" system in the coming weeks.

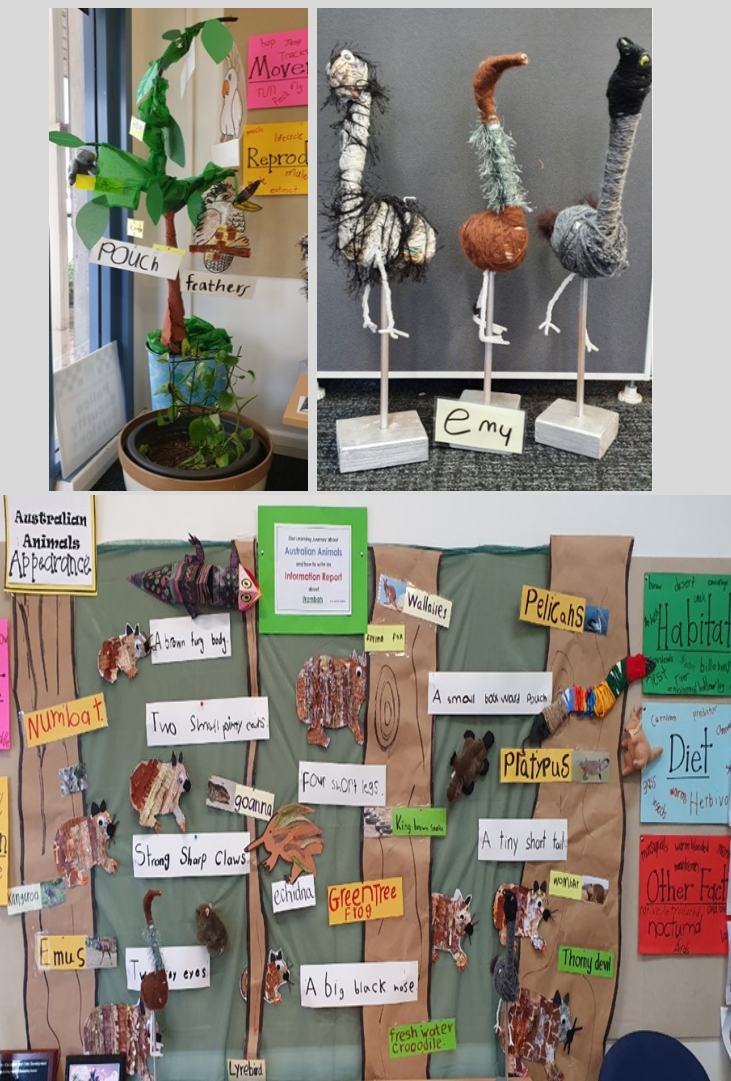
Once staff have been trained in this system we will open it up to families to enrol their children.
